CAR PARKING - PROPOSALS FOR 2013/2014

The Resources Committee met on Wednesday 14th November 2012 and considered the Annual Review of the performance of the car park operations and the proposals for the year 2013/2014. The full report of the meeting is available on the Council's web site at www.dorsetforyou.com if required. After due deliberation, the Committee resolved that the formal consultation procedure be carried out on the following proposals:-

Fees and charges

For the Shoppers Car Parks the proposed changes are:-

- (i) The introduction of an evening and overnight parking charge in Saxon Square, Bank Close, Wick Lane, Bridge Street, Bargates, Pit Site and Bypass Car Parks. The charge for parking between 7pm and 8am to be £1.00 in these car parks.

For the Beach Amenity Car Parks the proposed changes are:-

- (ii) The introduction of an 'Up to 8 hours' charge in Avon Beach Car Park and the charge to be £8.00 in March, April and May, £10.00 in June, July, August, September and October, and £5.00 in November, December, January and February.

The above proposals take into account the current market conditions and will generate the required income that the Council needs to help balance its budget for 2013/2014.

Annual Parking Permits

Proposed increases for 2013/2014 have been generally limited to 2%. The conditions of use of the annual parking permits are to be amended to allow two registration numbers on the permits.

The Resources Committee were once again pleased to support the traditional free parking within Highcliffe and Christchurch town centres in the run up to Christmas from Monday 17th December to Monday 24th December 2012.
